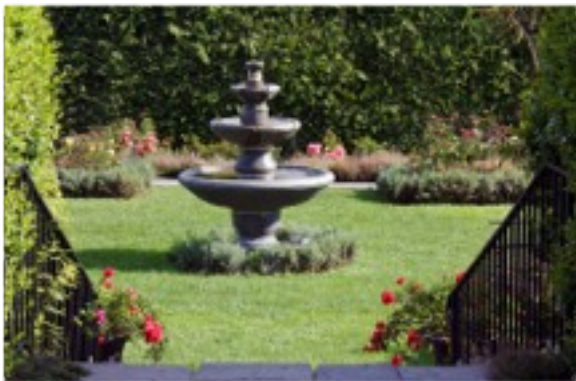

Rose Garden

Accommodates 120 guests.

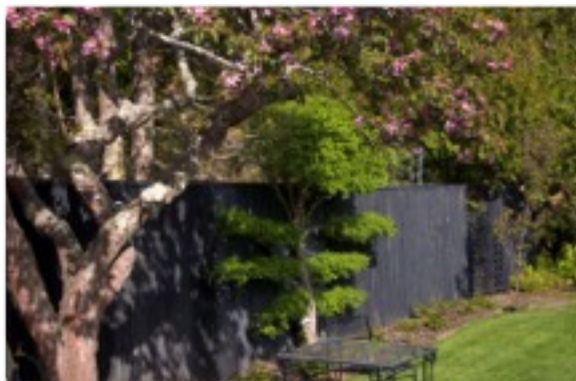




Back Courtyard

What's Included in your Ceremony Fee

- Initial meeting which includes a site visit and a follow up meeting 2 to 4 weeks after visit.
- Wedding coordinator onsite during your day.
- Support staff (as needed)
- 2 hours in your private site (entrance will be blocked off by staff member) for your ceremony
- Required signs for your ceremony
- Podium
- Signing table
- Power outlet (A sound system can be rented for a fee of \$100.00)
- Garden chairs (green in color)

For every 10 guests attending your wedding, Kingsbrae will provide you with one free hour of K. Bella Wedding Planning Service.

The Café

The Kingsbrae Garden Café is situated in the former turn of the century home designed by Edward Maxwell. The café looks out over generous, gently sloping lawns and twenty-seven magnificently landscaped acres. The Café can accommodate as many as 100 of your guests depending on the style of reception. Larger wedding parties can easily be accommodated on the main upper lawn of the garden providing that a tent is used.

Reception Styles

Plated (Sit Down) Reception: Seats 45

Cocktail Reception: Standing 85

Buffet Reception: Seats 45

Other Fees

Early Café closure (closes daily at 5pm) - \$200 per hour (The Café must be closed two hours prior to your reception)

Tent hosting fee - \$250

Evening site fee - \$500

After hours staff fee - \$50 for each hour after 5pm

Early Gift Shop closure fee (optional) - \$100 per hour

Entrance fee - \$9.00 per person (for a group of 12 or more) – This fee gives each guest a two-day pass to the Garden (the day of the ceremony and either the day before or after)

We welcome outsourced caterers. The fees for such are as follows: \$500 kitchen rental fee + \$25 per hour for kitchen supervisor. An additional \$500 damage deposit is required.
